PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

Roberto is a Mexican-British architect, who is a self-driven and highly creative individual with over 20 years of professional experience in the field of architecture and architectural design. Whilst working for international architecture studios he has designed and delivered projects in Europe, the Middle East, Asia and Mexico, these include mixed-use developments, master planning, residential, retail, commercial, education and civic projects. Roberto has extensive experience on the conceptualisation, design, coordination, management of teams and delivery of projects.

In April 2020, during the COVID Pandemic, he returned to Mexico after a period of eighteen years abroad. Since then he has been involved in the design and construction of a few domestic projects in Tepoztlán, Aguascalientes and Xochimilco, and in 2022 he joined the Masters and Doctorate Program in Architectural Design at the National University (UNAM) with the research project

Urban and Architectural Ecologization for the south of Mexico City: A critical approach based on Ecological Connectivity, Ecosystemic Urbanism, Green Infrastructure and Baubotanik. He is currently in the last stage of this academic process.

From March 2014 to April 2022 he founded an architectural consulting business, RE Architecture, based in Edinburgh, UK. to provide architectural advice and services to various clients. Projects from this period include the development of Whitehill Country Estate in Rosewell, Scotland with phase 2 'The Stables' recently completed. Also the residential conversion of the iconic *Whitehill House*, a magnificent 1844 historic building carefully restored and adapted to house modern style apartments. The construction of Knowlhill Business Park in Milton Keynes, Harveys Trade Park, and Straiton Trade Park for Southwark Investments Ltd. both completed in Edinburgh.

Roberto has participated as Guest Studio Tutor in the Edinburgh School of Architecture & Landscape Architecture (ESALA) of The University of Edinburgh, in the Master of Architecture Programme during the academic session 2017-2018.

From April 2011 to March 2014 Roberto worked for the international studio 10 Design, as Associate as well as founding member of the Edinburgh Studio and start-up 10Europe Ltd. effectively linking the Hong Kong based Headquarters and the newly formed Edinburgh Studio. During this period Roberto played a key role securing various projects for the new studio, travelling and living simultaneously in Hong Kong and Edinburgh. In

this period he participated in the design and development of diverse and varied projects in China, United Arab Emirates, India and Turkey including the 615,000 m2 Wanpu Development in Hangzhou, the 680,000 m2 Financial Innovation Park in Baoneng, the 100,000m2 residential development 'Seventh Heaven' in Dubai, the 50,000 m2 HQ for Ningbo Planning Buro Office, the 55,000 m2 Mavisehir Residential Development in Izmir and the 400,000 sqm Science and Technology Park 'Bay Valley' in Shanghai completed in 2014.

From May 2002 to April 2011 Roberto worked as Senior Designer for the British architecture firm RMJM Ltd., a world renowned award-winning architectural practice. He focused much of his work on international projects with success in the UK, Ireland, the Middle and Far East where he played a key role in the design and delivery of several high profile projects including the award winning 14,000m2 'Alice Perry' New Engineering Building for the National University of Ireland in Galway completed in 2011, winner of the RIAI Best Sustainable Project 2012, the RIAI Public Choice Award 2012, the ICS Best Sustainable Project Award 2011, the CMG Educational Building of the Year Award 2011 and runner-up for the ESB Engineering Project of the Year 2016, the building was voted as Ireland's favourite building in 2012. Also from this period is the Cregan Library for the University of Dublin, completed in 2015 as part of a major redevelopment project for St. Patrick's Campus which along with a new teaching and lecturing building formed the new flagship project for the institution, with a total cost of € 50M. Other key projects include the 2009 winning international competition entry for the 550,000m2 Zhuhai, Shizimen Business and Convention Center in China, completed in 2014, the 230,000m2 Moskovsky Mixed use development in St. Petersburg, Russia, the short listed international competition entry for the Federal National Council Parliament in Abu-Dhabi in collaboration with the New York office and the Beijing Security and Information Base, Beijing, China in collaboration with the late Will Alsop.

Roberto's experience during this intense period was instrumental and formative in his professional development and in the architectural studio where he was a distinguished member of the team, leading the conceptualisation and architectural design efforts for various projects and collaborating on a regular basis with other RMJM's studios including those in London, Cambridge, Glasgow, Dubai, Hong Kong and New York.

In February 1998, and prior to finishing University, Roberto founded the architectural studio TAE-X at the back of a competition win to design the De la Norma Chapel in Mexico City. In March 2001 he co-founded the studio R+U as a vehicle for collaboration with other architects and established offices in Mexico City until April 2002. There he developed designs for various projects including the Mariana del Toro Housing Refurbishment completed in Mexico City's Historic Centre in collaboration with Ars Habitat.

Other extra-office efforts led Roberto to participate in the international competition 'Palisades Glacier Mountain Hut' which was exhibited at the University of California, Berkeley in 2003 and selected for the prestigious 178th Annual Exhibition at the Royal Scottish Academy in 2004, meriting a special mention on the specialised British press that same year.

He played a key role in the design and development of several high-profile projects including, the multiple award-winning *NUIG Engineering Building*, won in an international competition in 2006, developed between 2008 and 2010, and completed in 2011, when it was named NUIG Engineering Building "Alice Perry". Other key projects he was involved include, the flagship project *Cregan Library* for the University of Dublin, completed in 2015 as part of the *St. Patrick's Campus Redevelopment Project*, along with a new Lecturing and Classroom building, and the refurbishment of some existing buildings, with a total area of 12,000m² and a cost of €50M. Also, the *Zhuhai International Convention and Exhibition Centre*, in Zhuhai, China, a project won in an international competition in 2009 and completed in 2014. The project is located at the intersection of the Palisades Glacier axis and the Big Pine Creek route, and it blends into the landscape as a wooden structure, anchored to a local stone fireplace. It comprises a communal building that houses social functions and a dormitory building where 30 bunk beds are housed. The two wings are articulated by a series of lines that constitute the different hiking routes, to which the building responds by integrating them into the structure, forming a subtle meeting point. Various landscape elements help “rooting” the architecture in its natural context, thus blurring the boundaries of the building, challenging the perception of where the architecture ends and where the natural landscape starts. The complex is oriented to maximise sunlight and has a large social room, dining room, community kitchen, a large stone fireplace, a biomass boiler, a storage area for skis and mountaineering equipment, space for 30 bunk beds, bedrooms shower, toilets and an area for drying biomass. The project was exhibited in Berkeley, at the University of California in 2003. It was also exhibited at the Royal Scottish Academy’s 178th Annual Exhibition in 2004, where it was positively received by the specialised critic, in what was a hard blow to Scottish design that year.
